The GVR Government Degree College, Dronachalam was established in the year 1979 in Kurnool District. There was no degree college for the students after completion of intermediate in Dronachalam. With the untiring efforts of the local philanthropist Sri.G.V. Rathnam Shetty, who donated six acres of land and one lakh of rupees for the construction of building this college came into existence. At present the college has six acres of land with 14 rooms, one seminar hall and digital class rooms. The college was affiliated to SV University, Tirupati till 1989 and from 1990 to 2008 it was affiliated to SK University Anantapur. In the year 2008 it got affiliated to Rayalaseema University. The college was accredited with B Grade by NAAC in the year 2015. The college offers undergraduate programmes in multiple disciplines like Arts, Science, Computer Science and Commerce.

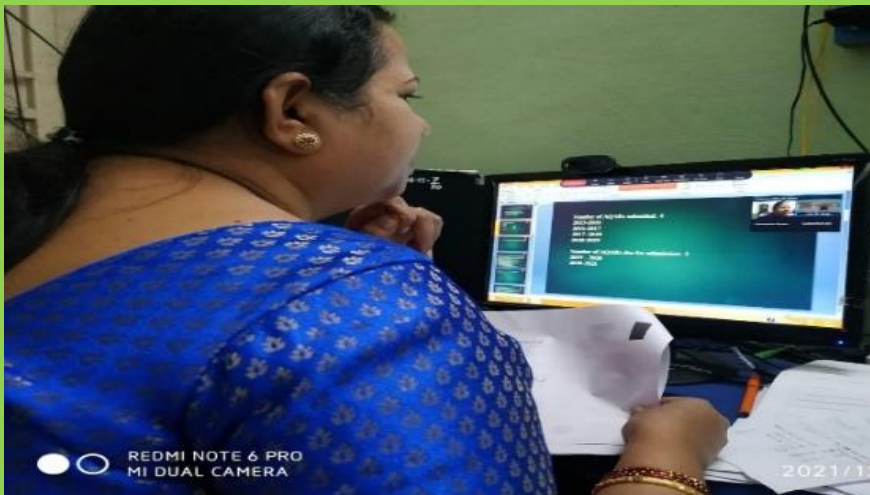
**Guest Lecture**

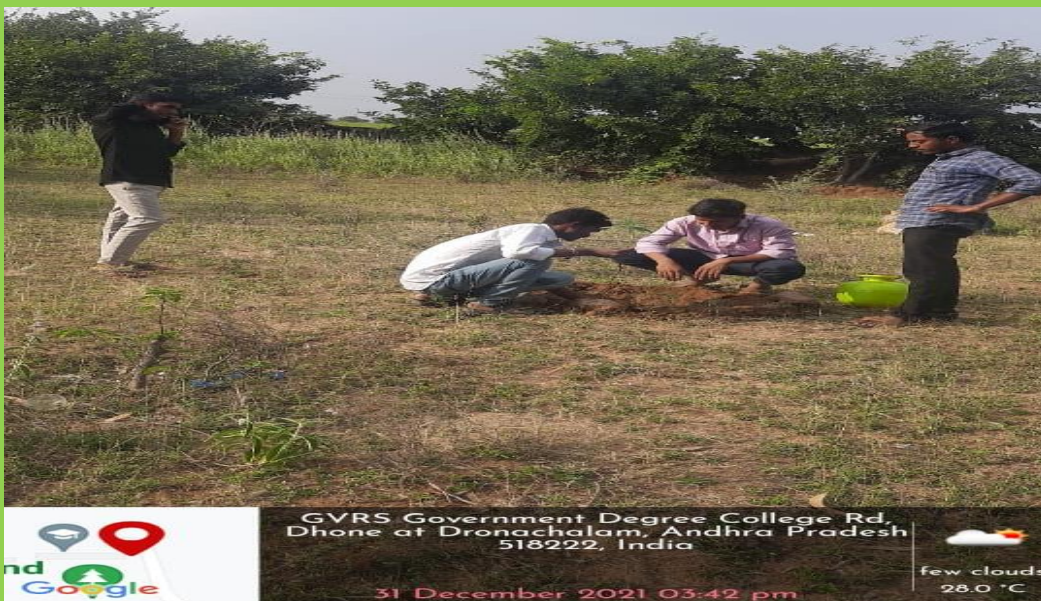
