Dr S Swarupa Rani, Head of the Botany Department attended as observer at Sankaras Degree College, Kurnool.

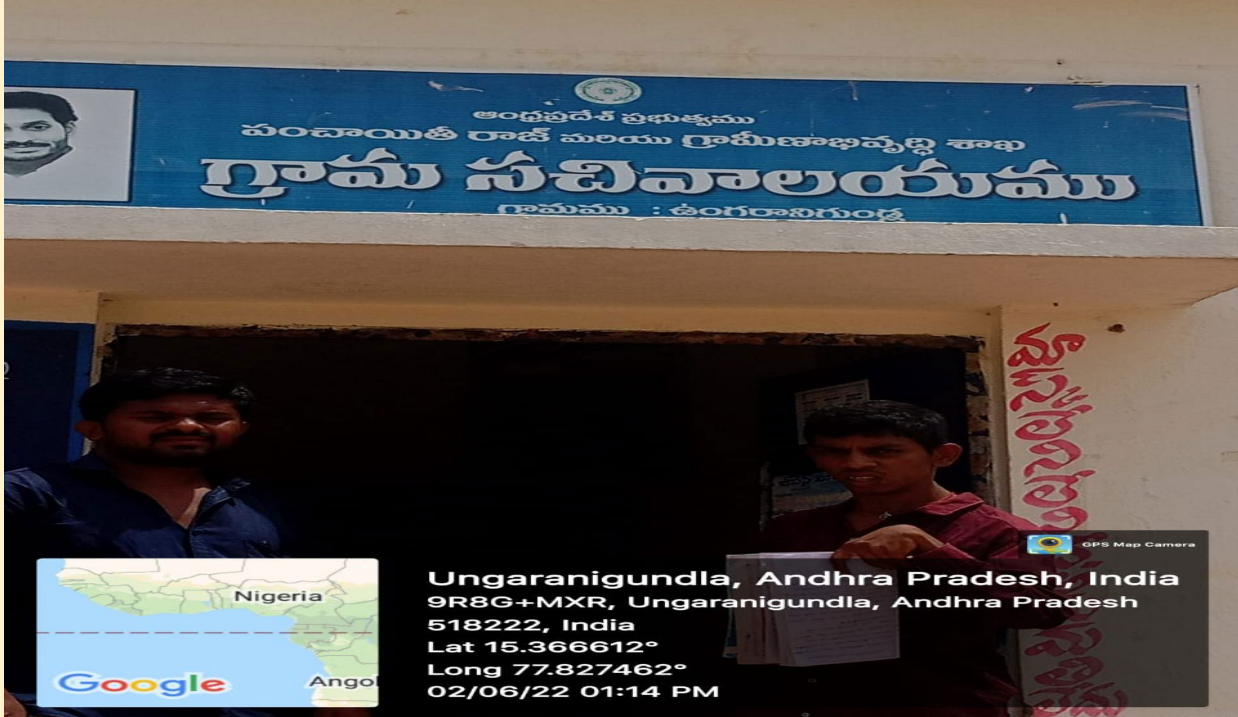


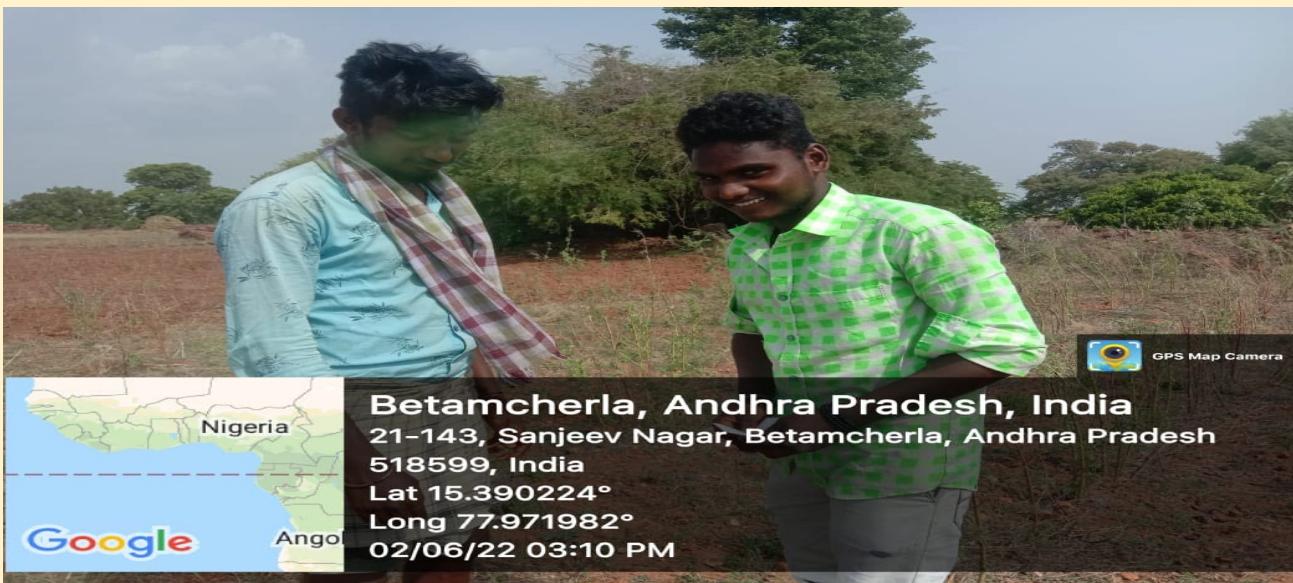
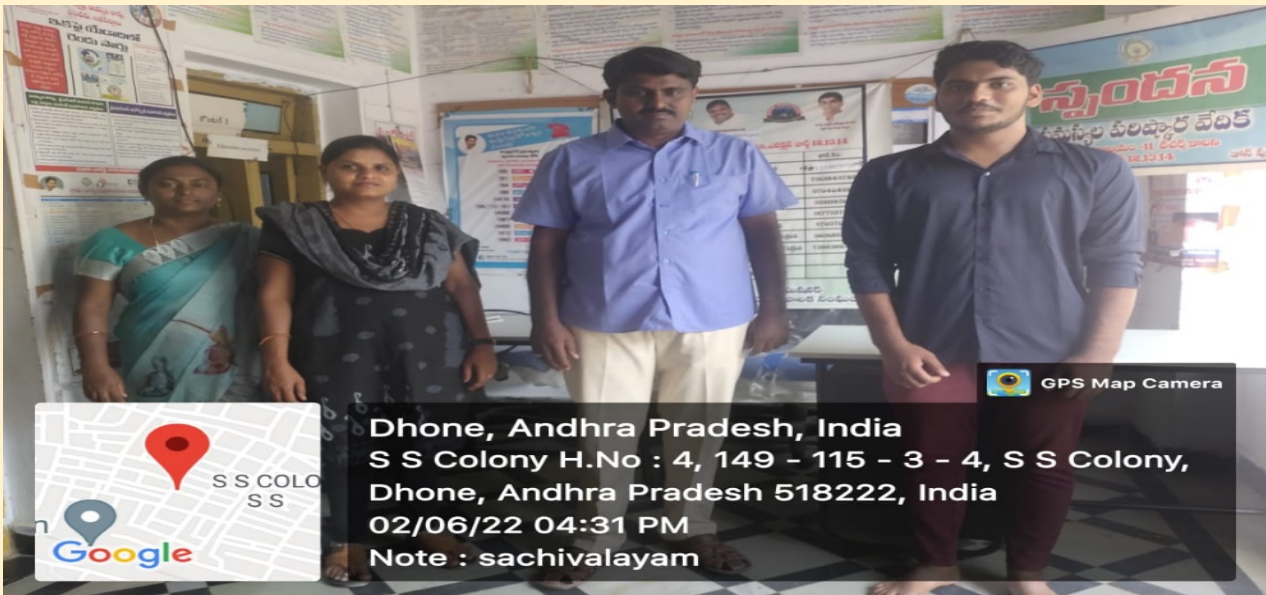
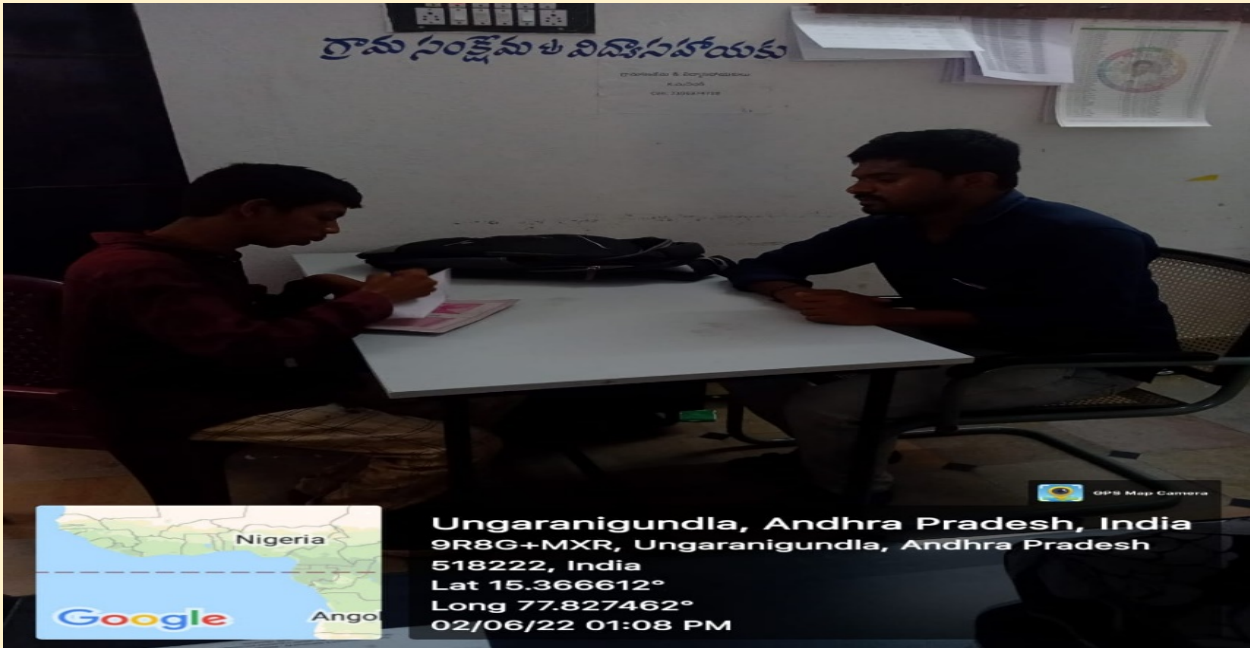
### News from Departments

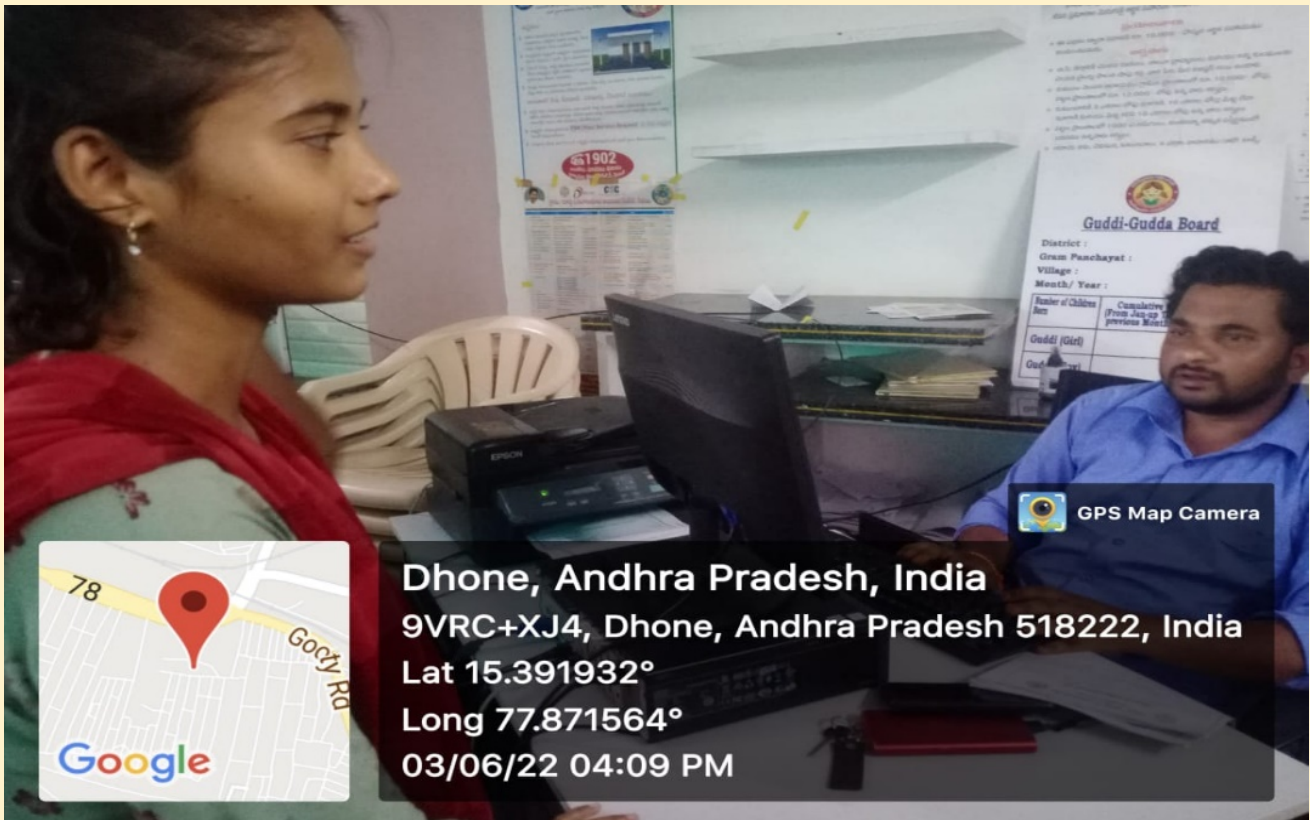
#### Community Service Project

Students from all the departments interacted with the locals as a part of Community Service Projects taken up in accordance with the instructions of the APCCE for second and fourth semester students. The students accompanied by their mentors visited the respective allotted places and collected the information required for their project. The aim of this programme is to create an awareness among the students about the socio - economic conditions of their fellow men and also to identify the problems and challenges faced by the respondents. The students in addition to knowing their socio-economic condition also survey on the topics allotted to them by directly contacting the residents of the area and administering the questionnaire. The students visited the areas in and around Dhone like Ungaranigundla, Hussainipuram etc in the month of May and June as well. Students went to village secretariates,

consulted the staff to get the required information. They spoke to agriculturists, farmers and field workers to know the patterns of farming and variety of crops grown. They also visited solar power plants to study the generation of solar energy and its distribution. They also attempted to know the cost involved in the solar plant installation and the institutional financial support if any, available to set up the solar plant. Students surveyed on drinking water resources. A survey was conducted on entrepreneurs.









### Open air classroom:

Students with the support of the faculty and Municipal employees cleared the space to start open air classroom. This activity was taken up on the occasion of World Environment Day ie on 5<sup>th</sup> June. The objective of having open air classroom is to provide the experience to the students of learning in open space and serene atmosphere. Principal of the college addressed the students in this open-air classroom.
