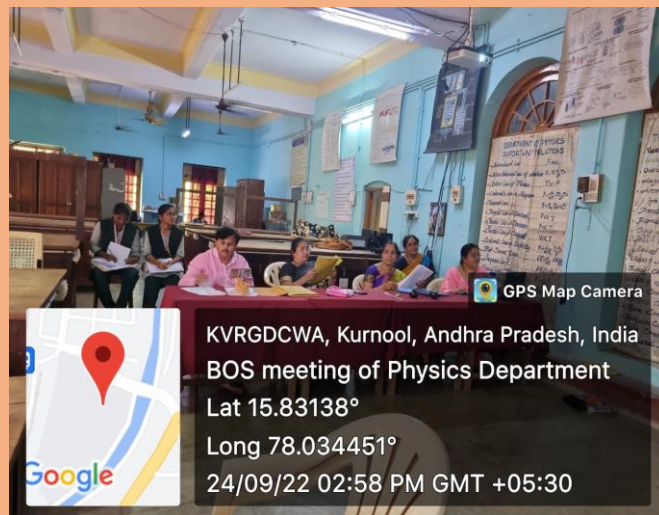
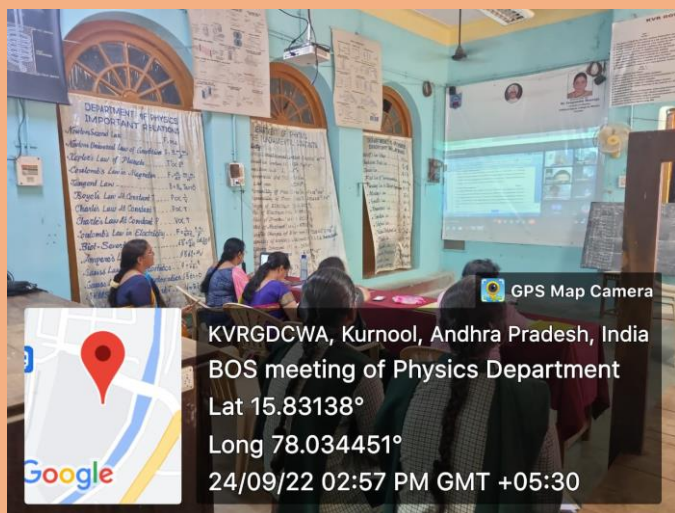


Guest lecture by Dr S Swarupa Rani on the concepts of Digital Herbarium at Ravindra degree college, Kurnool on 3rd September 2022.

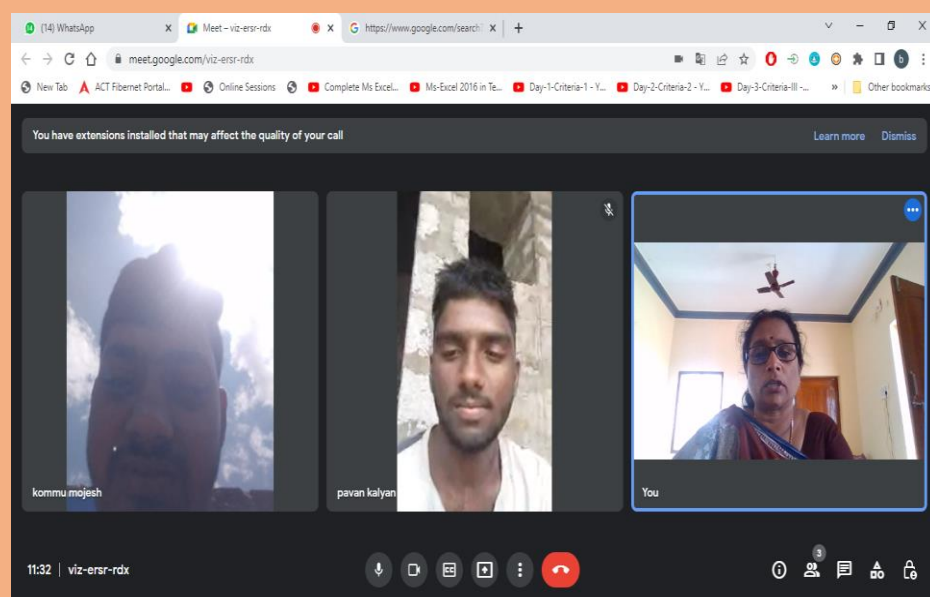

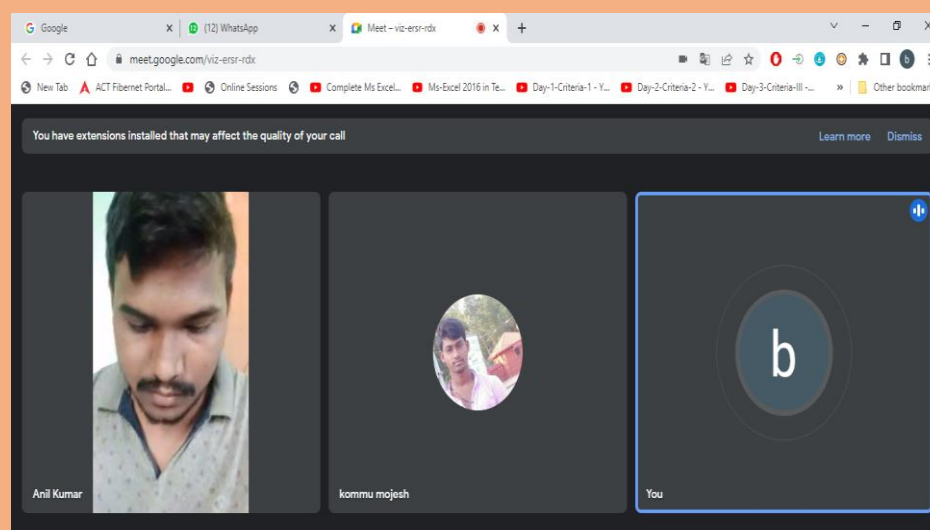
News from Departments

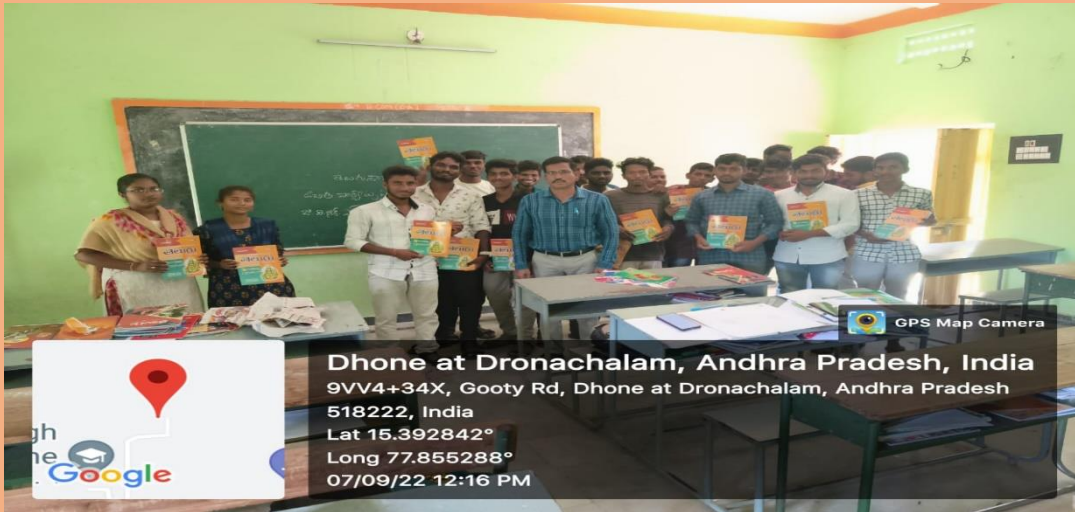
Guest lecture

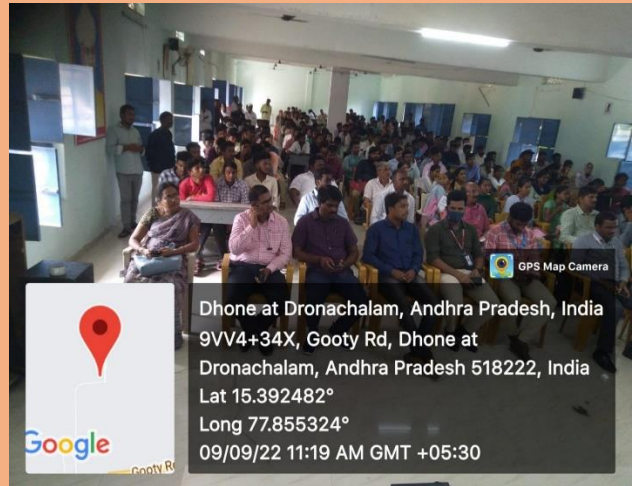

Vermicompost

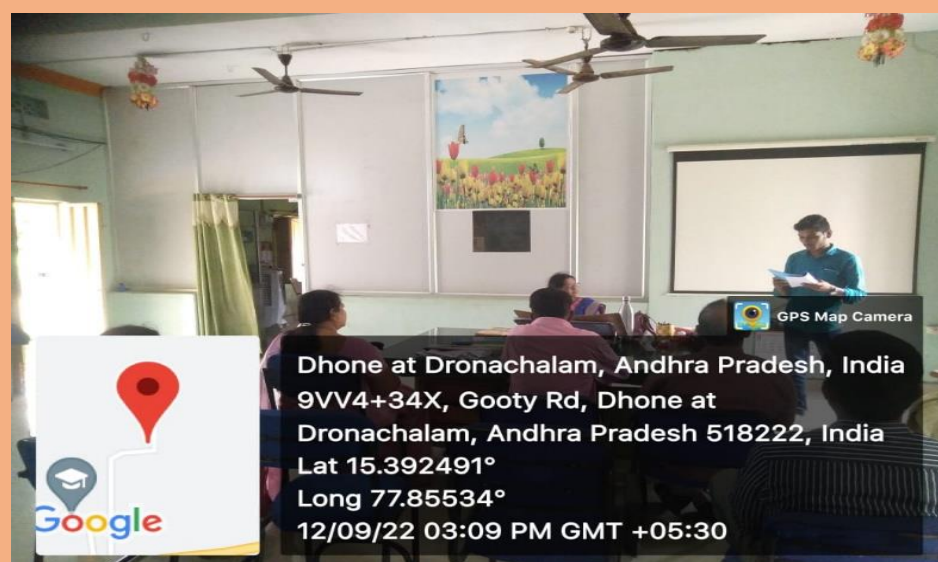

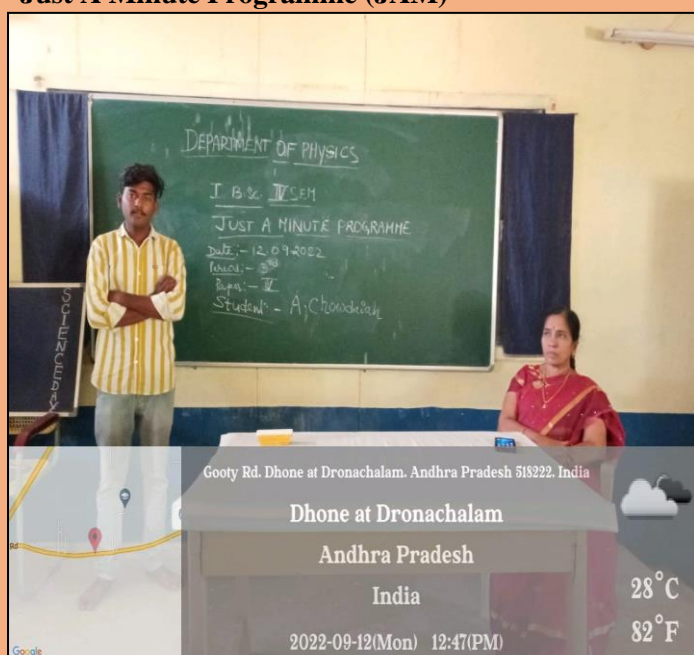
